KINGDOM LIVING CERTIFICATE PROGRAM

<u>CERTIFICATE OFFERED</u>: Kingdom Living Studies

Our Kingdom Living Program is a 1–year program. The courses available for this program are: The Person and Work of the Holy Spirit, Understanding our Spiritual Authority, Healing and Prophecy. A certificate is issued with the completion of all these courses.

PROGRAM OPERATION: Student Orientation: Last Thursday in August Classes: First Thursday in September - May

Courses are offered each year from September to May. A course consists of 2 units. A unit is 4 weeks in length, which equals 10 classroom hours–each class being 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ hours. You must complete a total of 8 units before receiving a certificate–8 units are offered each year. These 8 units are divided into 2 semesters. Students are required to complete assigned, at-home study with written homework.

Holidays: We take Thanksgiving Day off, but there is a make-up class on the preceding Tuesday. You have one week off for Christmas. We also give the week off for Tournament Week in February, and Spring Break in April. Refer to the enclosed School Schedule.

Clearly, it would be to your great advantage to attend the entire year of study for at least two consecutive years, and three years if you sense a call to the five-fold ministry.

This is just a reminder for your convenience. The full year is \$550.

1st: \$275–due by the night of Student Orientation (see below), which begins the first semester.

2nd: \$275–due in mid-January, which begins the second semester.

___Part-time students must pay all fees in advance.

Student Orientation: (Last Thursday of August)

Payments: Administrator collects all payments and issues receipts.
Books & Homework: Students receive books and homework for the first week of study.
The first homework assignment is to be completed before the first night of class.
Student Packets: Packets will be distributed and important issues addressed in detail.
Honor Code: All students are required to sign the ATM Honor Code.

Student Dress:

Class: Dress is casual yet modest, and jeans are allowed. **Awards & Graduation Service:** Dress up - slacks, no jeans.

KINGDOM LIVING COURSE DESCRIPTIONS*

Year One

THE PERSON AND THE WORK OF THE HOLY SPIRIT:

This course on the Holy Spirit is designed to help you gain more knowledge and understanding of Who the Holy Spirit is and what He does. Greater things are available for us from the Spirit of God. Knowing and understanding the Holy Spirit will lead us to a fuller, more powerful and victorious life in Christ. (2 Units-8 Wks.)

UNDERSTANDING OUR SPIRITUAL AUTHORITY:

Do we realize the awesome potential that we have as believers in Christ? As we study the Word of God and begin to understand the authority we have, we can then exercise that authority. Submitting to God and resisting the enemy with authority will cause him to flee, and God's power and blessings will be seen in and through us. (2 Unit-8 Wks.)

HEALING:

Jesus did not only die for our sins on the cross, but also bore strips on His back that we might live free of sickness and disease. Learn how to access all that has been given to you as a born-again believer. (2 Unit-8 Wks.)

PROPHECY:

Learn how to become sensitive to the voice of God, discern that it is His voice, then respond to and cooperate with the activity of the Spirit. You will learn how to activate the Gift of Prophecy, Tongues and Interpretation, the Word of Wisdom and the Word of Knowledge that is on the inside of your born-again spirit. (2 Units-8 Wks.)
